

Meeting Minutes

April 22, 2024

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Sweetwater Tennessee met in a called meeting and monthly workshop session on Monday, April 23, 2024 at 5 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Doyle F. Lowe called the meeting to order with Commissioners present being: Lamar Hughes, Sam Moser, Alan Richeson, JoAnna Jinks, and James H. Stutts. City Attorney John W. Cleveland was present.

No one was present to make a public comment. Commissioner Jinks advised the gates for the garage and landfill were ordered and should be here in three weeks. City Recorder Jessica Morgan reviewed the accounting procedures for street services, particularly those tied to specific receivables. She advised that the city account for those in a receivable instead of hitting an expenditure line item. No objections were voiced.

The board reviewed the Employee handbook draft and drug policy, defining safety sensitive in the handbook. They also reviewed the number for full time employees, asking that John Cleveland revise the draft to adjust the type of employees section to maintain 40 hours scheduled for full benefits and 30 hours for health insurance.

The board reviewed the proposed budget and advised they wanted to see numbers included to provide full benefits for three full time library workers and health insurance for 2 thirty-hour employee positions. No other changes were requested.

The board adjourned and reconvened as Sweetwater Beer Board to review the application for Welbur Enterprises LLC. The board tabled the application until the change in occupancy was approved by City Planner Jon Campbell.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
